Southeast Missouri Suicide Prevention, Inc. is a local non-profit organization that helps bring awareness, support and hope to those affected by suicide.

Per the CDC's verified data from 2020, suicide is the 3rd leading cause of death among 10-34 year-olds and 4th among 35-44 year-olds in Missouri. 90% of those that died by suicide had a diagnosable mental health condition at the time of their death. 54% of Americans have been affected by suicide in some way.

Proceeds from the *Illuminating Hope* walk benefit Southeast Missouri Suicide Prevention, Inc. We have set aside funds to help cover the cost for counseling services for those that qualify for financial hardship. We have been able to donate many items that fulfilled the wish list for the inpatient adolescent department of Southeast Behavioral Hospital. Additionally, we are contracted with local mental health providers to assist with direct referrals for those in urgent need of counseling services. We offer monthly teen support group meetings for our local youth to promote healthy mind and body wellness. We also have free educational training, such as Mental Health First Aid classes, available to our community.

Not only does our awareness walk help provide funds for local resources but it also provides an opportunity for individuals that have been affected by suicide or mental illness to come together and make connections. It brings hope to those that are struggling and comfort to those that have lost a loved one to suicide.

Purpose of Form

An individual or entity (Form W-9 requester) who is required to file an information return with the IRS must obtain your correct taxpayer identification number (TIN) which may be your social security number (SSN), individual taxpayer identification number (ITIN), adoption taxpayer identification number (ATIN), or employer identification number (EIN), to report on an information return the amount paid to you, or other amount reportable on an information return. Examples of information returns include, but are not limited to, the following.

- Form 1099-INT (interest earned or paid)
- Form 1099-DIV (dividends, including those from stocks or mutual funds)
- Form 1099-MISC (various types of income, prizes, awards, or gross proceeds)
- Form 1099-B (stock or mutual fund sales and certain other transactions by brokers)
- Form 1099-S (proceeds from real estate transactions)
- Form 1099-K (merchant card and third party network transactions)
- Form 1098 (home mortgage interest), 1098-E (student loan interest), 1098-T (tuition)
- Form 1099-C (canceled debt)
- Form 1099-A (acquisition or abandonment of secured property)

If you do not return Form W-9 to the requester with a TIN, you might be subject to backup withholding. See What is backup withholding, later.
